The development involves construction of a 32 megawatts solar farm. It also includes the construction of a new 18 kilometres (11 mi) 33kV transmission line from the power station to the electricity substation

Abu Dhabi-based Global South Utilities has commissioned Chad's first utility-scale solar plant, a 50 MW facility in N"Djamena with 5 MWh of storage to supply 274,000 homes.

Global South Utilities (GSU), Abu Dhabi-based energy firm, has commissioned the Noor Chad PV plant in N"Djamena, Chad's first utility-scale solar power plant with a 50 MW capacity.
